

- 1. **Start with the 3 Golden Questions:** How Can I Help You? What other Ideas do you have for me? Who else do you know that I should talk to?
- If you're not succeeding, you may be in the wrong room. Don't get stuck looking for love in all the wrong places.
- 3. Your problem is someone else's solution. Money, Ideas and Opportunities are attached to other people.
- 4. Measure relationships not by Net-Worth, but on their integrity. Do they have a good head, a good heart and a good gut?
- 5. **Strangers are dangerous is a fallacy.** Watch for warning signs, but this doesn't work when you are an adult.
- 6. **People must know you, like you and trust you before sharing valuable social capital.** Your network is golden, use it wisely.
- 7. **Don't get lost in the crowd.** A robust, wide and deep network will make you stand out in a crowd.
- 8. Introductions are your most valuable resource. Use them to create win-win value proposition for both parties.
